

Candidates eligible to avail the assistance of Scribe:

Computer Based Test (CBT) against GDCE

(Notification No. 01/2019/GDCE & 01/2020/GDCE)

- PwBD candidate with one arm/muscular weakness and Visually Impaired (VI) candidates/those candidates whose writing speed is affected by cerebral palsy can avail the assistance of a Scribe for writing answers on their behalf.
- Candidates as well as the Scribe will have to give a suitable undertaking in the enclosed Proforma. In case it transpires later that he/she did not fulfill any of the laid down eligibility criteria or there has been suppression of material facts, the candidature of the applicant will stand cancelled irrespective of the result of the examination. The Visually Impaired (VI) candidate shall be responsible for any misconduct on the part of Scribe brought by him/her.
- Candidate should submit a copy of the Disability Certificate which has been issued by an appropriate authority along with attached.
- Candidate will have to arrange their own Scribe at their own cost during the examination.
- The Scribe will read out the questions to the candidate and on the candidate stating clearly answer against each question, the Scribe will have to indicate the same. The Scribe should indicate the answer on the screen spelt by the candidate.
- A candidate availing the assistance of Scribe is eligible for extra time of 20 minutes for every hour of the examination.
- All one eyed candidates and Visually Impaired (VI) candidates whose visual degree of disability is less than 40% shall not be considered as Visually Impaired (VI) persons and the provision for engaging SCRIBE shall not be applicable to them.
- Those candidate desires to take the assistance of scribe should inform to chairmanrrcnrlpnr@gmail.com on or before 28.01.2021 to enable to take necessary arrangements. Such candidates may download at he "SCRIBE FORMAT", which is available in the RRC website i.e. www.rrcnr.org & submit the same at examination centre duly filling up all the fields as directed in the format. Failing which such candidates will be not be allowed to take up the examination.
